Dear Parents/Guardians,

Greetings from Don Bosco School, Ranchi!

Another successful academic year has gone by and it is time to start the new session with lot of enthusiasm and fervour.

In our dreams we all aspire for great things. Yet, most of us simply are not creating the results we want. Why not? What is holding us back? Fear keeps us away from taking action and if we don't act, we never get beyond where we are now. We have to look forward to the dreams. So, let us start right now today. Together we can all Dare to win. It is said that "A journey of a thousand miles begins with that single step."

There are certain things I would like to share with you for the smooth running of the new academic session. Don Bosco School aims to impart to all students sound education by forming habits of study, discipline, self-reliance and moral values during the years of their studies, so as to make them worthy citizens of the country. Don Bosco's system of education is based on conviction, prevention of false, paternal correction, loving kindness and the fear of God. Aiming at the total development of the students, the management and the teachers of all the classes have evaluated the students of each class during the past few days. Detailed discussions were held on various aspects of the growth of the students such as physical health, attendance, appearance, discipline, concentration neatness, in class, academic performance, participation in activities, parental follow up etc. We also referred to the reports, the remarks of the Unit Tests and the examinations and sincerely discerned what the best is for each student. The class teacher will communicate to you our opinions, concerns and suggestions. The printed remarks are a summary of lot of discussions. So, kindly accept the communication in the right spirit to promote your ward's growth. Being a collective decision after serious evaluation, the decision taken at those meetings will not be changed or reconsidered by the Principal alone.

01. FINAL EXAMS RESULT

Final Exams concluded on 22nd February 2020. The results of Final Exams will be given out for Class 8 on Wednesday, 04th March 2020; Class LKG to Class 7 on Saturday, 7th March 2020 and that of Class 9 and Class 11 on Thursday, 12th March 2020 from 8.00 am to 11.00 am. The criteria for promotion to next class are, first, a student must obtain 50 percent of marks in graded subjects (Moral Science/Catechism, English-3 & Hindi-3 and SUPW) and 40 percent of marks in other subjects. Secondly, he should have 85% of

attendance. Thirdly, Passing in English I & II subject is a must. There are many whose fees are still due. **Those who have not cleared their fee dues will not be allowed to collect the report cards**. Fee cards are to be shown to the Class teachers as a proof of having cleared the fee dues. Results will be withheld if all dues are not cleared. Anyone with genuine problems may always approach the school authorities. **The Principal will not meet anyone regarding the promotional matters.**

Those requiring Transfer Certificates will need to make an application addressed to the Principal and submit a fee of Rs. 100/- for the same. The Transfer certificate can be collected three days after the request has been made from the school office.

02. **NEW SCHOLASTIC YEAR : 2020 – 2021**

The new Academic Session 2020-2021 will begin on Thursday, 05th March 2020, for the students of Class 9, on Friday, 13th March 2020 for the students of Class 10 & 12 and on Tuesday, 17th March 2020 for the students of Classes LKG to 8. On the days of ICSE/ISC exams, classes will be held only for students of classes IX, X & XII. Students of classes LKG to VIII will have study leave on 20th, 23rd, 24th, 26th and 30th March 2020 due to ICSE/ISC Board Exams. The School timing for the New Scholastic Year 2020-2021 will be from 7.45 am to 02.15 pm for Classes I to XII and classes LKG & UKG from 07.45 am to 11.30 am. It is compulsory for all the students to be present in the school on the opening day of the school.

03. ICSE EXAMS

ICSE Exams has started on 27th February and will conclude on 30th March 2020. 147 students are appearing for CISCE Board Exam this year. Every effort has been made to prepare our children well for the exams. We wish our students **ALL THE BEST** and request you to keep them in your prayers. The Application Form for Class XI (Science & Commerce) will be uploaded in the School's website <u>www.donboscoranchi.com</u> on 01st March 2020. It can be collected from the School office as well.

04. ISC EXAMS

This year it will be the third batch of our school appearing in ISC (+2) Board Exams. There are 167 candidates appearing both in Science and Commerce streams. ISC Exam is going on and will conclude on 24th March 2020.

05. UNIFORM/ SHOES

All the students are to come to school in neat and tidy uniforms. Their shoes must be well polished. Parents are also expected to take a great care of their wards' uniforms. If the ward does not come well dressed, he/she will be sent back from the school. The parents have to see that their wards have proper haircuts; their nails are trimmed and they are properly dressed. Boys are requested not to wear tight trousers.
